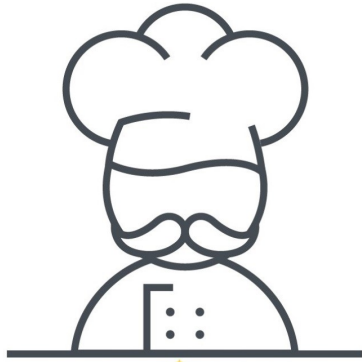

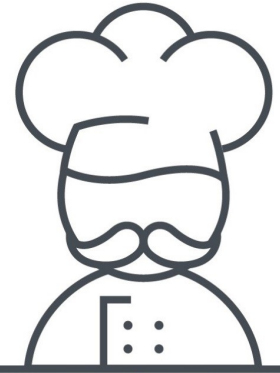

What happens at Rescue Mission of Mahoning Valley?

Meals...

- The Mission provides meals to anyone in need; 365 days a year.
- Last year, 165,504 meals were served. This is an increase of 122% in ten years.
- The cost to provide a donated meal is \$2.05.

Emergency Shelter...

- The Mission never closes and houses men, women and children. Ten years ago the number of individuals sheltered each night was 54.
- Last year, the Mission cared for an average of 122 people each night (a 130% percent increase).
- All totaled, that was 44,553 overnight stays. Children made up 6,222 of the stays.

Discipleship and Growth in Christ...

- Beyond providing food, clothing & shelter, the Mission is equipped to help individuals make a sustainable transition when they leave.
- Education, counseling and mentorship go a long way— but real change happens when the individual places their faith in Jesus Christ.

How is the Mission operated?

No Government Funds...

- Under God's care, the generosity of the people in the Mahoning Valley has sustained the Mission since 1893.
- The Mission is committed to breaking the entitlement cycle.
- 100% of every gift stays local.
